New Laws 2024

• Paid Sick Leave Expansion: Includes an updated wage theft notice for enhanced compliance.



 Leave of Absence for **Reproductive Loss Events:** Introducing a new leave option

for employees experiencing events like miscarriage.



• Minimum Wage Update (California): As of January 1, 2024, the minimum wage for all employers is \$16.00/hour. However, Fast Food Restaurant employers (effective April 1, 2024) and Healthcare Facility employers (effective June 1, 2024) will have higher minimum wage requirements. Stay informed about the changes in your industry.
