- Our Live Well San Diego vision in action!




This is the eighth year of Love Your Heart!

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Why Love Your Heart?



➡ High blood pressure was a primary or contributing cause of death for more than 410,000 Americans in 2014-- more than 1,100 deaths each day.

The good news? Although you cannot control all of your risk factors for high blood pressure, you can take steps to prevent or control high blood pressure and its complications.



Blood Pressure Categories



BLOOD PRESSURE CATEGORY	SYSTOLIC mm Hg (upper number)		DIASTOLIC mm Hg (lower number)
NORMAL	LESS THAN 120	and	LESS THAN 80
ELEVATED	120 – 12 9	and	LESS THAN 80
HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE (HYPERTENSION) STAGE 1	130 – 139	or	80 – 8 9
HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE (HYPERTENSION) STAGE 2	140 OR HIGHER	or	90 OR HIGHER
HYPERTENSIVE CRISIS (consult your doctor immediately)	HIGHER THAN 180	and/or	HIGHER THAN 120

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We collected the following information:

- ♥ Basic demographics (age range, gender, and ZIP code of residence)
- "Is the respondent currently taking blood pressure medication?"*
- Each person screened was put into one of the following blood pressure categories:
 - Normal, Elevated, Hypertension Stage 1, Hypertension Stage 2,
 Hypertensive Urgency, & Hypertensive Emergency



SCREENINGS PERFORMED BY YEAR 2012-2019







3,876 participants responded to a question about the use of BP medications.



21.6% said they were using BP meds



Of those who use BP meds, 82.6% had high BP

Of those who said they <u>did</u> not use BP medication, more than half had high BP.
